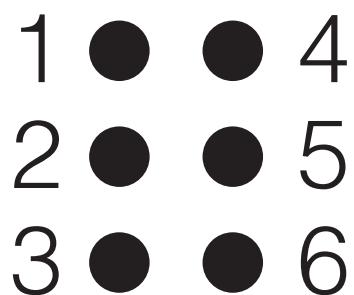

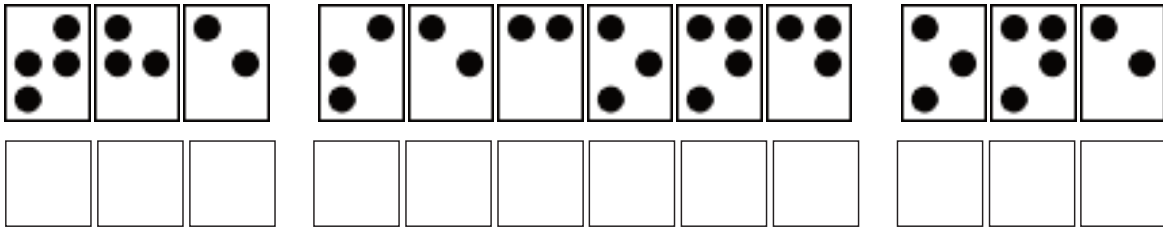
Using the braille alphabet below, try to solve these riddles by writing in the print letter above each braille symbol.

The six dots of the braille cell are arranged and numbered:

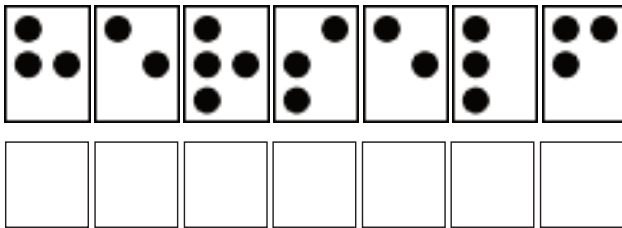
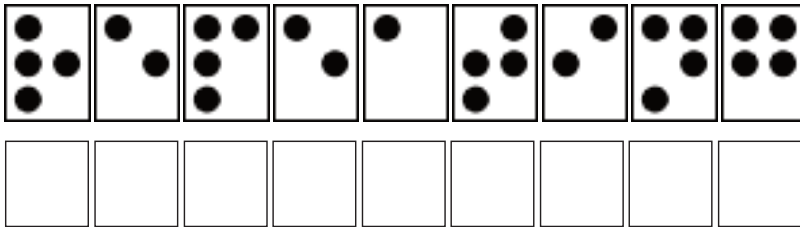
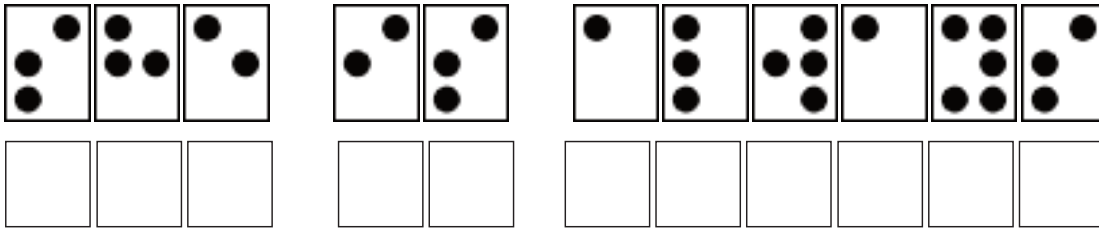
